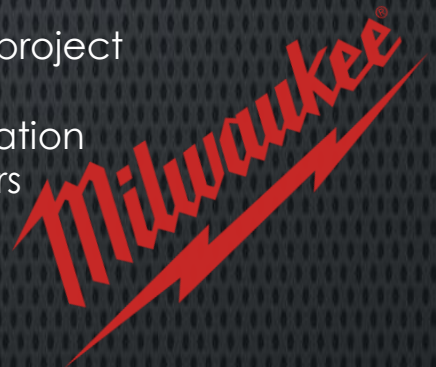
SEMINAR ON FIELD LEADERS EDUCATION
